RESPONSIBILITIES

- To coordinate the promotion and use of HYTES' teaching resources (education package and school presentation - <http://www.hytes.org/resources/teachers.html>) in Canadian schools.
- To coordinate the provision of additional outreach to schools and through general public events, through encouragement and facilitation of student fundraisers, penpal projects, etc.

QUALIFICATIONS

Passion for sharing information about HYTES and underlying issues of global poverty with Canadians, especially primary or secondary students. Teaching or public engagement experience considered an asset, as would previous volunteer management experience.

ORIENTATION

An overall orientation to HYTES will be provided upon acceptance of volunteer position. Fellow HYTES volunteers assisting with this project will offer an overview to the specific position and be on hand via email or phone to address any questions or concerns regarding this volunteer position as they arise.

TIME AND PLACE OF WORK

At your home, at your leisure (given that any deadlines set between the HYTES team and yourself are met!) using your own computer equipment/internet connection/phone line. Visits to schools or other venues of public engagement may be required.

COMMITMENT

To fulfil this HYTES volunteer role, you will be expected to provide support to the HYTES Board of Directors on an ad hoc basis for a minimum of one year. In addition to 1-2 hours for initial orientation, an estimated time of 6-7 hours per quarter would be expected.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Any public statements made must fit with the overall mission and spirit of HYTES and be suitable for the target audience at hand.
